Policies	Community Standards of Behavior
General Policy	Pursuant to the Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York, dated May 11, 1967, a Section 356 of the State Education Law, after consulting with the President, representatives of the faculty, and students, the Council of the State University of New York at Fredonia establishes and promulgates the following regulations concerning the conduct and behavior of students. The following rules and regulations were amended in December 2004 and May 2015. They were approved by the College Council and the President of the University in May 2015.
Statement of Jurisdiction	Attendance at this University is a privilege afforded the student by the State of New York and is a legal right. The determination of a student's fitness to be admitted to the university and continue as a student has been entrusted by the Board of Trustees of the State University to the President and their staff. The term "student" includes all persons taking regular classes at Fredonia, both full-time and part-time, pursuing undergraduate, graduate, or professional studies;
