A bias-related incident involves conduct (acts, behaviors, or communications) against a person, motivated by the offender's biases regarding age, disability, ethnicity, gender, gender identity/e pression, nation origin/nationality, race, religion, se, se ual orientation, veteran status or other identity. These acts, behaviors, conduct or communications may produce an unwelcoming environment. A bias incident may involve behavior which does not rise to the level of a violation of Auburn University policy, including legally protected free speech.
