

It is inappropriate to interfere with or compromise access to information technologies and communications facilities by others for these purposes. It is University policy to educate users about how they could inadvertently interfere with this access, to warn users when they interfere with access, and to remove access from those who continue to interfere with the access of others. While the University expects to remove individual access only after due process and careful consideration, in those situations in which interference is general or continuous, Information Services will react immediately to provide and guarantee general access. In all cases, Information Services will collect evidence indicating interference, will present it to the area vice president or to the appropriate

- The inappropriate access to and use of information and communications systems can in many cases result in criminal prosecution and civil litigation.
