The advertise ent appears on page 89, i ediately adjacent to the rankings of the top 100 national universities. e have enclosed a copy of the issue for your infor ation. FIRE plans to continue its advertise ents in ws each year to bring attention to the colleges and universities that ake up our "Red Alert" list. The increased traffic the advertise ent brings to FIRE's website, thefire.org, as well as the negative attention it draws to the universities aking up the list, ake it all the ore disappointing that FIRE ust include Michigan State University a ong the "worst of the worst" for protecting liberty on ca pus.

FIRE takes no pleasure in keeping Michigan State on its Red Alert list. As an organization that prides itself on its ability to quickly resolve disputes, we find it especially disappointing that student speech rea ins threatened at Michigan State, and ay in fact be in ore peril than it was a year ago. FIRE is no less deter ined, however, to continue to expose and fight abuses of liberty on A erica's ca puses and at Red Alert institutions ost of all.

Taking this step will cost Michigan State nothing and will only save the university fro the further e barrass ent of having to publicly defend its indefensible disregard of student rights.
